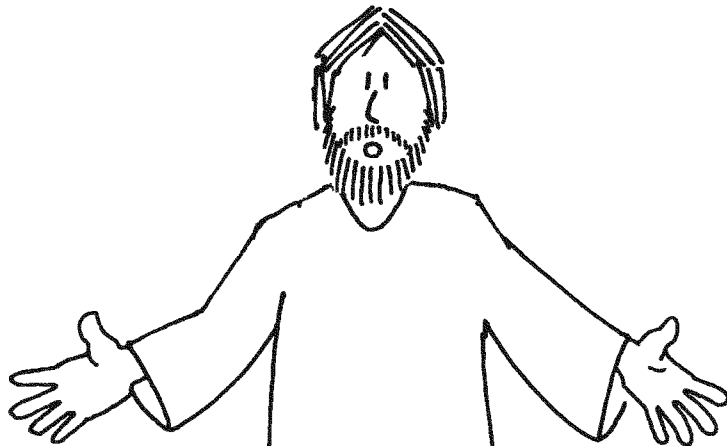
The disciples asked Jesus, "Is this man blind because he or his parents sinned?"
